

JEF Portugal - 2º Photo Contest

Contest rules

TOPIC:

The JEF Portugal II Photo Contest is subject to a specific theme: "Smiles".

PARTICIPANTS:

The contest is opened to all amateur photographers, national or foreign, living in Portugal or any other country of the European Union, and who will not be more than 35 years old on 31st December 2006.

Those who are still minors (between 15 and 18 years) are allowed to participate as long as they have their parents' authorisation and they hand in this authorisation at the time of their application.

The enrolment in this contest will cost €5 (five Euros).

JEF Portugal members are not allowed to participate in the contest.

WORKS IN CONTEST:

Each participant may present a maximum of five unpublished photographs and the jury will be entitled to eliminate any and all photographs that do not comply with the topic and regulation of this contest.

Black and white and colour photographs are allowed - Digital and/or 35 mm.

Works resulting from any process of digital manipulation will not be accepted.

The works presented should obey the following sizes:

- . 15 x 20 – minimum
- . 20 x 30 – maximum

The works should not be laid out on light cardboards or any other supports/frames.

The photographs will be identified through a pseudonym used by the author, printed in Caps on the back of the works and together with the title.

The photographs should be delivered in a sealed envelope and the pseudonym used by the author should be written on the front of the envelope.

Each participant must send in a separate and sealed envelope (pseudonym on the front of the envelope), his registration form together with a copy of his Identity Card.

None of the works presented in the contest shall be returned.

SCHEDULING:

Works will only be accepted until the 31st December 2006 at 07:00 pm, at the following address:

The works may be sent by registered mail to the above address and the date of the stamp on the envelope or on the mail registry will be considered as the valid date of delivery to the contest.

JEF Portugal will not be liable for any damages or losses of any of the works presented to the contest prior or after the delivery of said works at the contest.

The photographs rewarded by the jury as well as other rewarded works will be included in a collective exhibition which shall take place in a date and place to be settled.

The results will be disclosed between 31st January and 15 February 2007.

THE JURY OF THE CONTEST

The jury will consist of a professional photographer, a representative of the sponsors, and two representatives of JEF Portugal.

The jury may decide not to attribute any prize at all as long as such deliberation is duly justified.

The jury may attribute honourable mentions.

There will be no appeal to the jury's deliberations and these are irrevocable.

COPYRIGHT

The owners of the works will waive their copyright to JEF Portugal so that JEF Portugal may reproduce the works in all of its publications, on paper or digital, as well as in any of JEF's activities, without any financial or any other compensation.

JEF Portugal will always mention the name of the authors and the title of the works.

Any other form of publication not included in JEF Portugal's activities will require the previous and express consent by the authors.

1st Prize: € 175

2nd Prize: € 100

3rd Prize: € 50
